| Incident Description: On 03/19/2021 at PRTC, (DOB (DOB)) had an x-ray conducted of his right hand due to him complaining of pain from an incident that occurred on 03/13/2021, in which he became upset during a voluntary time out and started punching the door. At the time of the incident, nursing staff assessed him, gave him Ibuprofen and an ice pack for pain, and wrote a consultation to see the doctor. The x-ray revealed an acute fracture to the 5th metacarpal with no displacement. A follow-up with the doctor has been ordered. | |

Ronissa Adams responded from the agency on 3-29-21 stating "So my understanding of the situation there was 3 staff on the unit with 24 - and when the resident was in open time a nurse went over with staff to assist with
