They have been placed on a 6 foot no interaction, however it is their choice whether or not they interact as we cannot physically stop them. The staff are aware of the altercation that occurred and the clinical team is processing the situation with both residents."

Details from Follow-up: Agency notified specialist of incident that occured at dinnertime in the cafeteria on a Friday night. Child was irritating another child by tapping his shoulder with a spoon. The other child punched him in the face. The child was taken to the doctor and assessed. The children are on a 6ft no contact order and staff are aware of that order and are on alert to de-escalate if needed. Staff was nearby and ratio was appropriate when incident occured.
