Do you believe your rights have been violated or that you have been discriminated against based on your disability at school, at work, in housing, or where you receive services?

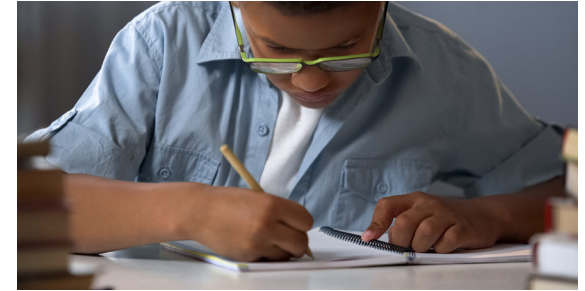
Do you believe you have been neglected or abused in the facility where you receive services?
