Supporting Narrative By GHOOKER, 01/11/19 00:50

Narrative

On 01/10/19 at approximately 1351 hours, I, Deputy G. Hooker was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to an assault. Upon arrival, deputies made contact with Siegrist Youth Home director, Rita Williams. Ms. Williams advised deputies that a student [REDACTED] attacked another student [REDACTED] in the hallway. Ms. Williams stated that the parties were separated and there were no serious injuries. Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] began antagonizing her in the hallway without provocation. [REDACTED] stated that she became irritated with [REDACTED] comments and began reciprocating negative comments. [REDACTED] stated that at this point, [REDACTED] pulled her to the ground by her hair and punched her twice in the back of the head with a closed fist. [REDACTED] advised staff members then intervened and separated the girls. [REDACTED] advised she did not have any injuries but did complain of soreness in her head and neck area. [REDACTED] declined medical treatment. [REDACTED] grandfather, Jerry Boren, was contacted and advised of the situation. Mr. Boren advised he was en route to this location and would like to press charges. Contact was made with [REDACTED] corroborated [REDACTED] statement. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] became upset with [REDACTED] and pulled her to the ground by her hair and punched her twice in the back of the head with a closed fist. [REDACTED] advised she was not injured in the incident and did not require medical treatment.

Furlough, was contacted and advised of the situation. Ms. Furlough advised she would be en route to this location shortly. Deputies made contact with Kendra Iverson. Ms. Iverson advised she witnessed the entire event. Ms. Iverson echoed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] statements advising [REDACTED] began antagonizing [REDACTED] in the hallway before pulling her to the ground by her hair and punching her twice in the head with a closed fist. Staff members were able to provide video footage of the attack. Deputies viewed the footage which showed [REDACTED] pulling [REDACTED] to the ground by her hair. The camera angle did not catch any punches being thrown but it was apparent that [REDACTED] was the aggressor. Staff members provided deputies with a copy of this footage. Deputies contacted the Pulaski County Juvenile officer who advised deputies to issue [REDACTED] a citation. Deputies advised [REDACTED] that she was being charged with Battery 3rd(5-13-203) and would need to appear in Pulaski County Juvenile Court on 02/11/19. Deputies provided [REDACTED] and Ms. Furlough with a copy of the citation. Video footage of the incident was entered into tracker and stored in the PCSO property room as evidence. All involved parties were provided with a report number and advised how to obtain a copy.
