## **Supporting Narrative By CROBBINS, 02/05/19 14:29**

### **Narrative**

On Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at approximately 1124 hours, I, along with Deputy J. Tallent were dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, Little Rock, AR in order to assist MEMS due to a student on scene needing transport to acute care. We spoke with a Ms. Melissa Baker, who is [REDACTED]' counselor at the Youth Home. Ms. Baker stated that [REDACTED] had several outbursts and was being disorderly disrupting the operations of the facility. Ms. Baker stated that the decisions had been made to transfer [REDACTED] to Bridgeway for acute care. Ms. Baker stated that [REDACTED] never attempted to assault staff that he had just hit the walls. MEMS unit 330 arrived at the Youth Home and we stood by while MEMS staff prepared to transport [REDACTED]. MEMS unit 330 departed the Youth Home transporting [REDACTED] without incident.
