### **Narrative**

On 03/27/2019 around 1250 hours, I responded to the youth home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to an assist agency (MEMS) report. Upon arrival I made contact with Ms. Rita Williams who is a staff member of the youth home. Ms. Williams stated [REDACTED] a student at the youth home has a tendency to become aggressive towards MEMS personnel, and asked if Deputies can standby to prevent an incident. Deputies stood by while [REDACTED] went with MEMS Unit 86 without incident. According to Ms. Williams Laura Williams [REDACTED] mother was notified of the incident. Deputies were not made aware of the reason for the transportation of [REDACTED].
