On 4-8-2019 at approximately 1016 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a 16 Y/O
who overdosed on an unknown amount of medication. Upon my arrival, I made contact with Allyson Shoptaw
(Therapist). Allyson advised me that, sometime between 1000 and 1020 hours, got a bottle of
ibuprofen and swallowed the pills inside. Allyson estimated that took 30 pills. Allyson advised that
say anything about wanting to harm herself but she had been expressing suicidal tendencies for the past week. Allysor
advised that suffers from severe depression and PTSD. Allyson advised that told a nurse after she took
the pills. I attempted to speak with would not answer any questions and became very nervous. I was
advised by Allyson that does not do well talking with males because of some past history. The female staff
attempted to ask the same questions and only stated It seemed like the thing to do. The room was
cleared of as many males as possible until MEMS arrival. MEMS arrived on scene and took
Arkansas Childrens Hospital for further treatment.
