Supporting Narrative By PSIMMONS, 04/29/19 12:27

Narrative

On 04/29/2019 around 1045 hours, I was dispatched to The Youth Home, located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to an attempted suicide report. Upon arrival, I made contact with Caitlin Henthorne, who is a staff member at the Youth Home. Ms. Henthorne stated that [REDACTED] a student, at the Youth Home came to school this morning with a bad attitude. Ms. Henthorne stated [REDACTED] made several threats to her, and other staff members saying that he wanted to kill himself, by cutting his wrist with a razor blade. Ms. Henthorne stated she found a razor blade in [REDACTED] possession, which she recovered, and safely discarded it, before notifying the authorities. I made contact with [REDACTED] who admitted to making those suicide threats to Ms. Henthorne, and other staff members. [REDACTED] had no other weapons on his persons. MEMS Unit 602 responded and transported [REDACTED] to Childrens Hospital without further incident. Ms. Henthorne advised Deputies that Dustin Miller, the father was notified of the incident.
