Narrative

On 5-20-2019 at approximately 0846 hours, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a battery. Upon my arrival I made contact with Caitlin Henthorne, staff member/victim. Caitlin advised me that student and another student have been arguing over social media all weekend. was in class and the female student he had been arguing with walked into the class. An argument started and a male staff member got between them. The female backed up and the male staff member stayed with Caitlin walked into the room to assist. As she was getting the female to leave the room, rushed towards Caitlin and the female student. Caitlin turned around and grabbed her by the neck. Caitlin and the male staff member held until he calmed down. Caitlin had red marks left on her neck where had grabbed her. I made contact with Juvenile Officer M. Carter. Officer M.
