Case Narrative**

On 5-18-19, at approximately 18:54, I responded to 4253 North Crossover Road for a criminal mischief report. Upon arrival, I made contact with Celese N. Smith. Smith was sitting in the driver's seat of her 2007 black Toyota Corolla LE bearing Mississippi vehicle license DAA2651. The vehicle was parked on the south side parking lot. Smith noticed a female later identified as Lesli K. Sherwin operating a 2012 GMC Sierra bearing Arkansas vehicle license 230WZW. Sherwin parked the GMC Sierra in the parking lot right next to Smith's Toyota Corolla. Sherwin opened the driver's side door to exit the GMC Sierra and the door struck the passenger side door of Smith's Toyota Corolla. Smith asked Sherwin if the door caused any damage to her vehicle. Sherwin told Smith that there was no damage. Lesli then went back into the building.

Smith got out of Toyota and looked at her passenger door. Smith noted multiple small scratch marks to the passenger door of her Toyota and contacted the Police Department. I looked at the door and noticed five small scratch marks to the passenger door. I went into the building and located Sherwin. According to Sherwin, she opened the driver's side door to her GMC and struck the door of the Toyota on accident. Sherwin and I walked outside to where the vehicles were parked. Sherwin opened the door to her GMC to show me where the door would have caused the damage to the Toyota. I determined the GMC door would have only scratched the Toyota once, because of the angle the door opened. The other four scratch marks would have happened on a different occasion.

I gave both subjects a contact card with my information and told them they could contact the police department for the report.
