BATTERY

On 07-26-2019 at approximately 1608 hours, Deputies R. Jones and P. Simmons were dispatched to contact Dee Kamp via cell phone in reference to an abuse report that occurred on Friday 07-19-2019.

Contact was made with Ms Kamp and she advised Deputies that she felt that her daughter [REDACTED] was being abused and mistreated by staff members at the Youth Home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road where her daughter resides. Ms Kamp stated that [REDACTED] called home upset stating that she had gotten bored at the youth home and admitted to misbehaving by making a slip and slide in a hallway. Ms Kamp stated that [REDACTED] stated that an employee Mr Oscar had grabbed [REDACTED] hands and [REDACTED] snatched away, then Mr Oscar grabbed her by the throat picking her up off the floor and threw her in a segregated room causing her to bump her head against the wall.

Deputies responded to the Youth Home to make contact with the staff members that were present during that incident. Contact was made with Ms Maxine McIntosh who is a Qualified Behavioral Health Care Provider (QBHCP) for the Youth Home. Ms McIntosh stated that during activity time [REDACTED] along with other kids in the facility were participating in a slip and slide activity which included soap, shampoo and water where they would mix the three together and slide down the hallway as a game. Ms McIntosh stated [REDACTED] became upset when Oscar and Maxine stopped the activity. Ms McIntosh stated that [REDACTED] was out of control when Oscar attempted to restrain her, [REDACTED] then snatched away. Ms McIntosh stated that Mr Oscar then did a one person restraint in which she did observe [REDACTED] feet come off the ground but she did not witness his hands around her throat. Ms McIntosh stated that Mr Oscar then placed her inside of the seclusion room without further incident.

Deputies then made contact with Gloria Reyes who is the QBHCP advised that she did not witness any inappropriate use of restraint on [REDACTED]. Ms Gloria did state that she observed Mr Oscar restrain Ms [REDACTED] by wrapping his arms around her shoulders to get a hold onto her but Ms [REDACTED] continued to slide her arms up and out of the hold. Ms Gloria stated that [REDACTED] had gotten wild at that of point kicking, throwing punches, and yelling at Mr Oscar. Mr Oscar struggled to get her to the seclusion room but he finally got her inside. Ms Gloria stated that she tried very hard to stay out of the incident due to Mr Oscar being her son and she wanted to make sure that there would not be any conflict of interest to the incident. Ms Gloria along with Oscar and Ms McIntosh observed [REDACTED] banging her own head against the walls and punching the walls with her fists inside the seclusion room.

Deputies inquired about the cameras and Ms McIntosh along with Ms Gloria stated that the camera system were not working on Friday 07-19-2019 but are back working as of Monday 07-22-2019.

Mr Oscar was not available to give a statement.

██████████ stated that on Friday 07-19-2019, she and her roommate initiated the slip and slide activity. ██████████ stated that she was instructed to stop what she was doing but she refused. ██████████ stated that when Mr Oscar approached her that he grabbed her wrists and it resurfaced a terrible memory from her past and she snatched away. ██████████ stated in her words "I just lost it". ██████████ stated that Mr Oscar restrained her by putting her in a head lock then proceeded to force her to walk. ██████████ stated that she was hitting him trying to get him to release her but he continued to hang onto her. ██████████ stated that when they made it a couple feet away from the seclusion room door, Mr Oscar then reached for her neck grabbing her throat and throwing her inside of the room causing her to bump her head on the wall. ██████████ stated that while inside the room she was punching the wall because she was very angry. ██████████ stated that after 20 minutes of her lashing out, a nurse gave her a shot to calm her down. ██████████ stated that she informed a staff member of her head injury and the staff member brought her an ice pack for her head. Ms ██████████ was not aware of the staff members name but that she was a black female and that was her first time ever seeing her so she assumed maybe she was a new employee. ██████████ stated that she was in the seclusion room for a total of 30 to 40 minutes then she was placed on a 24 hours observation status in a segregated room. ██████████ stated that she was finally able to contact her mother Dee Kamp on Saturday night when she came off the observation status. ██████████ denied ever banging her head on the wall. ██████████ was never provided professional medical care and did not request any medical assistance.

Prior to todays incident there were no reports filed indicating that an incident took place. Deputies provided staff members with the incident number.

██████████ was provided with the incident number and was advised of the warrant process.

A copy of the report was forwarded to the Child Abuse Hotline as per a requirement of mandatory reporting.
