
On 07-26-2019 at approximately 1608 hours, Deputies R. Jones and P. Simmons were dispatched to contact Dee Kamp via cell phone in reference to an abuse report that occurred on Friday 07-19-2019.

Contact was made with Ms Kamp and she advised Deputies that she felt that her daughter was being abused and mistreated by staff members at the Youth Home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road where her daughter called home upset stating that she had gotten bored at the youth home and resides. Ms Kamp stated that admitted to misbehaving by making a slip and slide in a hallway. Ms Kamp stated that stated that an employee stated that an employee snatched away, then Mr Oscar grabbed her by the throat picking her Mr Oscar had grabbed hands and up off the floor and threw her in a segregated room causing her to bump her head against the wall. Deputies responded to the Youth Home to make contact with the staff members that were present during that incident. Contact was made with Ms Maxine McIntosh who is a Qualified Behavioral Health Care Provider (QBHCP) for the Youth Home. Ms McIntosh stated that during activity time along with other kids in the facility were participating in a slip and slide activity which included soap, shampoo and water where they would mix the three together and slide down the hallway as a game. Ms McIntosh stated became upset when Oscar and Maxine stopped the activity. Ms McIntosh stated that was out of control when Oscar attempted to restrain her, then snatched away. Ms McIntosh stated that Mr Oscar then did a one person restraint in which she did observe feet come off the ground but she did not witness his hands around her throat. Ms McIntosh stated that Mr Oscar then placed her inside of the seclusion room without further incident. Deputies then made contact with Gloria Reyes who is the QBHCP advised that she did not witness any inappropriate use of restraint on . Ms Gloria did state that she observed Mr Oscar restrain Ms by wrapping his arms around her shoulders to get a hold onto her but Ms continued to slide her arms up and out of the hold. Ms Gloria had gotten wild at that of point kicking, throwing punches, and yelling at Mr Oscar. Mr Oscar stated that struggled to get her to the seclusion room but he finally got her inside. Ms Gloria stated that she tried very hard to stay out of the incident due to Mr Oscar being her son and she wanted to make sure that there would not be any conflict of interest to the incident. Ms Gloria along with Oscar and Ms McIntosh observed banging her own head against the walls and punching the walls with her fists inside the seclusion room.

Deputies inquired about the cameras and Ms McIntosh along with Ms Gloria stated that the camera system were not working on Friday 07-19-2019 but are back working as of Monday 07-22-2019.

Mr Oscar was not available to give a statement.
