TERRORISTIC THREATENING

On Tuesday, August 27, 2019, at approximately 1346 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Rd., Little Rock, AR to investigate an incident of Terroristic Threatening.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with a Ms. Renita Parker (complainant) who is a counselor/teacher with the Youth Home, Inc. Ms. Parker stated that she was conducting class at approximately 1030 hours when she overheard two students making threats directed at another student. The first suspect is a and the second are juveniles. The threats were directed at a suspect is a Both another student at the Youth Home. is also a juvenile. repeatedly stated that they were going to, "Shoot up Ms. Parker stated that well as the whole street." Ms. Parker also overheard stating, "This will be taken care of by GD's." The term GD is often used to identify a street gang known as the Gangster Disciples. Ms Parker informed me that have previously made reference to their alleged gang activity prior to this incident. The cause for these threats stems from an alleged social media posting made by Ms. Parker advised me that she was going to inform both that due to their threats, they would be suspended from school tomorrow. She ask me to accompany her to meet with stating she was concerned that they may become violent and/or aggressive. When Ms. Parker and I made contact with they both began acting agitated and questioned why the police had been called on them. Ms. Parker explained the seriousness of making threats of violence against another student. denied any involvement while stated, "I always say what I mean." During the entire time when were in my presence, they both acted in a defiant manner and often stated, "GD going

When I questioned both about making threats to "shoot up nouse", they both denied making any threats and questioned why I was there.

I continued to stay with Ms. Parker until both boarded a school bus to be taken home. left the Youth Home property without incident.
