Information

On 10/14/19 at approximately 1130 hours, Deputies F. McGee and P. Simmons were dispatched to the Youth Home, which is located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to a Narcotic Violation.

Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with a Ms. Caitlin Henthron, who is a staff member at the Youth Home. Ms. Henthron stated [redacted] gave a student [redacted] an unknown pill to take sometime this morning. Ms. Henthron stated she didn't know if the pill given by [redacted] to [redacted] was a narcotic or not. Ms. Henthron stated that she heard from numerous kids after breakfast. Ms. Henthron stated she confronted [redacted] about taking a pill and she confessed that she ingested a pill that she received from [redacted] Ms. Henthron stated its against schools policy for students "to pass off pills, or medication of any kind".

Deputies made contact with [redacted] He stated that it was not a narcotic that he gave [redacted] he stated it was his prescription medication Zoloft, which is used for depression. [redacted] stated that [redacted] asked for the medication, "and I gave it to her". At the time of contact with [redacted] didn't have any medication in his possession.

Deputies made contact with [redacted] who stated she asked [redacted] for the "pill" this morning at school. MEMS was not called out and [redacted] appeared to be normal. [redacted] was sent back to class and [redacted] was expelled from school and was taken home by his grandmother [redacted] School officials advised deputies that [redacted] parents was notified of the incident.
