Friday, October 18, 2019 at 11:25AM, Lt. Eric McCoy, Sgt. Jonathan Fought and I, Ptl. Gloria Aldridge, were dispatched to Woodridge Behavioral Care, located at 1521 Albert St. Upon arrival, we spoke with Mr. Andre Mills, The Youth Care Lead and his co-worker, Mr. Jacserri Jackson, A Youth Care Worker. They both reported that they want to file assault charges against one of the juvenile residents, 16 year old [REDACTED]. Mr. Jackson stated that [REDACTED] jumped the fence this morning and he had to chase him. He stated that when he caught [REDACTED] he took him back to the facility and [REDACTED] had to be held down until he calmed down. He stated that 3 of them had to take turns holding him because [REDACTED] kept fighting them and they were tired. Mr. Jackson reported that he received an injury to his left forearm. He stated that there are no visible injuries but there is pain. Mr. Mills also stated that he was injured during the incident. He stated that his right arm was injured by [REDACTED] but there were no visible injuries. They stated that he was kicking and each time that they had to let go of [REDACTED] to change workers, he punched them. [REDACTED] had no visible injuries and he didn't complain of any. [REDACTED] stated that he didn't get into an altercation today.

We were advised that [REDACTED] stay at the facility was not court ordered. He was arrested, charged with 2nd Degree Assault and transported to the station. His DHS Caseworker, April, in Jackson County was contacted. Both victims were advised of the warrant/summons process and they stated that they will go through the affidavit process.
