## Primary Narrative By Paris Simmons, 10/10/19 19:33

### Information

On 0/10/10/2019 around 1813 hours, I responded to the Youth Home, located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to a welfare check.

Upon arrival, I made contact Ms. Maybelline Redix, who is a staff member at the youth home. Ms. Redix stated that one of her students, [REDACTED], was being combative towards another student, [REDACTED]. Ms. Redix stated she stepped in between the two separating them before it became physical prior to my arrival.

I made contact with [REDACTED], who was in his bedroom, sitting on his bed. [REDACTED] stated he was upset with [REDACTED], because [REDACTED] likes to bully other kids around. [REDACTED] stated that he was tired of it, and he was going to do something about it. After talking with [REDACTED], about making better choices, I was able to calm him down. [REDACTED] agreed to keep his distance from [REDACTED].

Contact was made with [REDACTED] who stated that [REDACTED] approached him with an attitude for no reason at all, and that Ms. Redix stepped in between them before it became physical.

There was no physical altercation therefore no other action was taken.
