On 11/18/19, I (Deputy Braxton) responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a reported fight.

| Upon arrival, I made contact with Jerome Hunter (Youth Home employee) at #9 Crestview House, a youth group home. Hunter stated that while they were at the DHS Central Office that and were arguing about who was going to ride in the front seat of the van. Hunter stated that he observed pulling from the front seat of the van and body slamming him on the ground. Hunter stated that he saw kicking in the facial area and arm. Hunter stated that he pulled official and separated the two. Hunter stated that rode in a different van back to the youth group home. Hunter stated that when they got back to the dorm, they advised that he will be given a three day punishment for his actions. Hunter stated that made a statement about going after again in an aggressive matter, but was behind a closed door and unaware about what had transpired. Hunter instructed a staff member to call 911 and went and sat down on the couch. |

| I made contact with in the lobby of the youth group home. I asked about what happened this evening and he refused to give a statement. I asked what is his name and date of birth and he refused to give me personal identifiable information. At this point I gave more time to cool off because he had both fists clinched and had his head down in his lap. I observed no visible injuries on |
| I spoke to about what happened. Stated that he was unsure about what the argument was about. Stated that while he was putting his drink in the front seat of the van, hit him with the van door. Stated that his body was halfway inside the van at that time and punched him with a closed fist. I asked where punched him and he stated in the back, facial area, head, thigh, and arm. Stated that he attempted to hit back out of self-defense, but was unsuccessful. Stated that grabbed him and body slammed him on the ground. Stated that began kicking him in the facial area, back, arm, and thigh while he was on the ground. Stated that Hunter came to the van and pulled off of him and separated them both. Stated that they rode in separate vans back to the youth group home. I observed marks on back. I observed a knot and redness on or orehead, specifically the right side. I asked did say anything to him when they got back to the dorm and he stated no because they never came back in contact with each other. Then later informed Deputies that the argument was over who was going to ride in the front seat back to the youth group home. According to Hunter, was seen by the youth group home medical staff for his injuires. |
| I took photographs of injuries. Hunter informed Deputies that they were in the process of finding arrangements |

for tonight. I informed about the process of seeking legal action with the caseworker and going to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office. The photographs obtained in the incident are submitted into the department's evidence storage for documentation purposes. I provided Hunter a report number since all documents have to be forwarded to caseworker and the youth group home chain of command. I attempted to get a statement from again and he refused to talk to Deputies. Hunter informed Deputies that they both are court ordered to the youth group home.
