## Primary Narrative By Robin Jones, 01/03/20 17:28

On 01-03-2020 at approximately 1636 hours, I, Deputy R. Jones, was dispatched to contact a complainant via phone in reference to an assault.

I made phone contact with the complainant, Gregory Simmons. Gregory stated that on 12-25-2019 at around 1745 was being disciplined for instigating a situation with his peers. Gregory stated that hours a juvenile, punishment was to write an essay on how he could have avoided instigating his peers. Gregory stated that refused to write the essay and yelled to Gregory "Fuck Off!!". Gregory stated that due to was advised that he had lost his privileges and he got upset. Gregory stated that ran to a door as if he was trying to escape. Gregory stated that the staff attempted to stop by grabbing nim to get control of him but he then began pushing and attempting to slap the staff. Gregory stated that picked up a chair and attempted to throw it at staff and then kicked Gregory in his groin. Gregory stated that he pushed off of body to get away from him. Gregory stated that took off running down the hallway and began kicking on a door. Gregory stated broke a piece of metal off of a scale and was attempting to cut staff. Gregory stated that they then did an all call requesting all staff respond to assist. Gregory stated that once he got the assistance needed, was then placed in an acute unit for about two days. Gregory stated that this is 3rd time attacking him.

Gregory was provided with the incident number and advised to contact the Prosecutor Attorney's Office for further assistance.
