Terroristic Threat

On January 10, 2020 at 1038 hours, Deputies J. West and J. Tallent were dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road, in reference to a Terroristic Threat.

Upon arrival deputies spoke with the complainant (Cheyenne Daugherty) who stated that a student had made several verbal threats towards another student by saying "she would stab a kid named [REDACTED] in his throat, and drown him in a river under a bridge".

Daugherty stated that the other [REDACTED] was not present when [REDACTED] made those threats, and that the threats were spoken out loud, to where Daugherty heard them and reported them. Daugherty stated that [REDACTED] was not present when the [REDACTED] made the threats.

Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] the student who made the threats, and advised that she could be in serious trouble, if she makes those threats again, and possibly be kicked out of school for the behavior. [REDACTED] acknowledged that she understood, and that she would not make any threats again.

Daugherty advised that [REDACTED] had received two days, of suspension at home, and that her mother was contacted to come pick her up. Daugherty advised that the incident was being handled within the school but needed a report on record.

A report number was issued, deputies advised if there were any other question's or concern's to call the Sheriff's Office for further information.
