Battery 2nd

On January 13, 2020 at approximately 1001 hours, I was dispatched to Youth Home Inc., located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to an assault on a staff member. I arrived and spoke with Terry Hill who is a Behavior Specialist with Youth Home Inc. She stated that [redacted] was involved in a physical altercation with another student earlier. Hill stated that she was assisting in breaking up the altercation and had grabbed [redacted] by one of her arms to pull her back. [redacted] had a free hand and turned and slapped her in the left side of her face. Hill did not have any visible injuries but complained of pain to the left side of her face and neck area. Hill is also 60 years of age. Hill also left and went to seek a medical evaluation.

I had Hill complete a witness statement while I contacted Pulaski County Juvenile Intake. I spoke with Marty Carter and advised what had occurred and my charges against [redacted]. I was advised to cite [redacted] out to Juvenile Court and to give her a court date of February 11, 2020 at 0900. While waiting on [redacted] grandfather she was in the hallway and stopped and told Hill, "I'm sorry and that I only hit you because I was angry." [redacted] grandfather [redacted] was contacted and once he arrived [redacted] was cited and turned over to his custody.
