stated on 01-13-2020, at around 0945 hours, she was in Ms Parker's second period science class.  stated another student, over heard her statement and began calling her a whore and slut. Stated she told "that is why your grandmother has cancer". Stated that then slapped her on the side of her face causing her to fall to the floor. Stated that then walked over to where she was located lying on the floor and closed fist punched her on the forehead. Stated several people then began to pull the two apart. Stated she was seperated from and walked to an isolation room to calm down. Stated her grandfather, Jerry Boren, arrived to take her home for the day.
