Terroristic Threat

On January 30, 2020, at approximately 1349 hours, Deputy J. Tallent and Deputy J. West were dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a terroristic threat.

Upon arrival Deputies made contact with the complainant Rita Williams, who stated she was sitting in her office doing paperwork, while students were walking in the hallway, when she heard a student say "he will put a bullet in her head".

Ms. William stated she walked into the hallway, and saw the student making those comments to which is another student.

Deputies made contact with and he stated "That he was walking in the hallway with Ms. when he made the comment "put a bullet in her head". then stated that he did not mean to make the comment, he was upset and did not know what else to say.

Deputies advised to that he could not make those comments again because he could get into trouble for such comments.

stated that he was sorry for the comment and stated that he would never take such an action.

The incident number was provided to Mrs. Williams and she was advised to call the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office if the incident occurred again.
