Medicall

On February 1, 2020 at approximately 1034 hours, I was dispatched to The Youth Home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a 15 year old student who had intentionally cut himself with a razor blade. Dispatch advised that Youth Home staff was able to remove the razor blade from the student, but had no details on the extent of the injury.

I arrived and West Pulaski Fire Department Rescue was already on scene and was treating the student, who was identified as [REDACTED]. They advised me [REDACTED] had a laceration on his left wrist that was approximately 1 inch in length and a ¼ inch wide. [REDACTED] stated that he is a "cutter" and cuts to relieve stress. I saw several old cuts on both of his arms. I spoke with the staff member Gregory Simmons, who stated that [REDACTED] needed to be transported to Arkansas Children's Hospital for evaluation for his cut as well as a mental evaluation. He further stated to me that staff noticed [REDACTED] was cutting himself with the razor blade and they were able to get the razor blade away from [REDACTED] without using force.

MEMS arrived and transported [REDACTED] to the hospital without incident.
