## Primary Narrative By Douglas Bjork, 02/02/20 14:42

### Disturbance

On February 2, 2020 at approximately 1024 hours, I was dispatched to the Youth Home Inc, located at 204000 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a disturbance. I was advised that there was a 17 year old residence that was throwing rocks at staff members. Dispatch then advised that they have lost contact with the caller. After dispatch reestablish contact with the Youth Home, it was learned that the staff was able to contain the residence inside of the residence. Lieutenant O'Nale and I arrived and made contact with the complainant, Gregory Simmons.

He stated that [REDACTED], who was sitting on the counter, had become upset with staff and started throwing things and kicking doors. He stated that [REDACTED] has been diagnosed with several mental health issues and they were in the process of getting him admitted into a treatment facility for evaluation and care.

Simmons stated [REDACTED] and other residence were in a group meeting and something was said to upset [REDACTED]. Simmons stated that [REDACTED] started yelling and creating issues with other residences. Simmons stated that he attempted to calm [REDACTED] down. Simmons stated that he was unable to and [REDACTED] then went to his room and ripped off his bedroom door and continued to yell. [REDACTED] then went outside and started throwing rocks at the building and in the general direction of staff, however he stated that they were not in danger of being hit.

[REDACTED] then came back in but the door was closed so he kicked the door causing damage to it. Simmons stated that they needed assistance in getting [REDACTED] to a treatment facility. After several attempts and with PCSO assistance a bed space was located at Rivendell Behavior Health Services of Arkansas. Simmons along with the Pulaski County Arkansas Department of Human Service requested that I take [REDACTED] to the facility based off the conduct of [REDACTED]. It was cleared by Lieutenant O'Nale and [REDACTED] was transported without incident.
