Information

Wednesday, February 12, 2020, at approximately 1341 hours, Deputy Tallent and I, Deputy Penister were dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a report of terroristic threatening.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the Qualified Behavior Health Provider, Ms. Charron Drew. Ms. Drew stated two students had a verbal altercation over a bean bag chair. [REDACTED] got upset because another student, [REDACTED] sat in the chair first. Along with another Qualified Behavior Health Provider, Ms. Ashley Washington, they evacuated the classroom so [REDACTED] could be restrained out of the presence of the other children. After all the children evacuated the classroom, [REDACTED] said "there's going to be some fucking dead bodies, starting with that fat fuck [REDACTED] I'm going to go for his family next, I would go for my family but they are my family."

Ms. Drew stated that no children were around [REDACTED] when he made the comment and later advised that he is on the autism spectrum. Ms. Drew stated that the therapist is working with [REDACTED] about his acting out.

I made contact with [REDACTED] who was located in the library. [REDACTED] stated he didn't mean what he said, he was just upset at the moment.
