Missing Person

Wednesday, February 19, 2020, at approximately 1817 hours, I, Deputy K. Penister was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Colonel Glenn Youth Home) in reference to a juvenile runaway.

Upon arrival I was accompanied by Sgt. Manning. I made contact with the House Parent, Mr. Melvin Walker. Mr. Walker stated he was en-route to the youth home when he saw one of the tenants [REDACTED] walking. He picked Mr. [REDACTED] up and Mr. [REDACTED] informed him that Mr. Joseph [REDACTED] had ran away. Mr. Walker stated he looked for Mr. [REDACTED] but was unsuccessful, he also made contact with Mr. [REDACTED] legal guardian, DHS Family Service Caseworker, Ms. Carson Taylor and advised her of the situation. Mr. Walker stated he made contact with Hot Springs Police Department as well as Garland County Sheriff's Department and advised them of the situation, due to Mr. [REDACTED] originating from Hot Springs, Arkansas and having relatives who resides there.

Mr. [REDACTED] was present at the time, with Mr. Walker's permission, I made contact with Mr. [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] stated at approximately 1600 hours, Mr. [REDACTED] fixed a flat for a fellow student and received \$10.00, he and Mr. [REDACTED] caught a ride (Grey jeep/SUV, unknown make/model/driver) with the unknown student to Walgreen's parking lot (unknown exact location), and walked to Larry's Pizza, located on HWY 10 in the shopping center. Once they made it to the shopping center, Mr. [REDACTED] I tried to convince him to runaway to Jacksonville or Hot Springs. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he told Mr. [REDACTED] he wasn't from here and he didn't know anyone in Jacksonville. According to Mr. [REDACTED] he tried to convince Mr. [REDACTED] not to runaway but he insisted on "splitting," at that point he started walking to the youth home, and Mr. [REDACTED] advised him that he was going to catch the city bus. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he didn't know the exact location Mr. [REDACTED] was en route to but suspects he was going to Jacksonville or Hot Springs. According to Mr. [REDACTED], Mr. [REDACTED] was last seen wearing a white hat (Under Armour) black Adidas jacket(white T-shirt underneath), blue basketball shorts (black Nike compression shorts underneath), and blue Nike tennis shoes (black Nike socks).

I gave Mr. Walker the incident report number and advised him to call Pulaski County Sheriff's Office if Mr. [REDACTED] returned or if needed.

I received a NCIC number (M385176173) via dispatch, who advised me that Mr. [REDACTED] had been reported missing on 06/04/2019, by Garland County Sheriff's Department, and had not been cleared from the system. Completed a Missing Person Report for NCIC Record Entry. A copy of the report was turned into dispatch to be placed in records and the original was turned into Pulaski County Sheriff's Office.
