SUICIDE ATTEMPT

On 03-16-2020, at approximately 1656 hours, I, Deputy R. Jones, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a suicide attempt.

Upon arrival, I noticed two staff members waving their hands in the air to gain my attention. I pulled into the parking lot of the Seibert building. The staff members advised me the subject, [REDACTED], was inside the building. When I walked into the building, staff members guided me to the secretary's office, where [REDACTED] was located. I noticed [REDACTED] standing against the wall, by himself, with his hands down by his side. I placed handcuffs on [REDACTED] and observed blood on both of his arms with several cuts. Staff members advised, the glass [REDACTED] used to cut himself had been taken away. I walked [REDACTED] to a chair and advised him to have a seat to await medical. When asked, [REDACTED] refused to provide a statement as to why he wanted to harm himself.

I made contact with Quality Behavioral Healthcare Provider, Jerome Hunter. Jerome stated around 1600 hours, [REDACTED] had been in an altercation with another student at the "House" which is building 9. Jerome stated when [REDACTED] and the other student were seperated, [REDACTED] went to the kitchen and broke a glass cup. Jerome stated [REDACTED] picked up a piece of the broken glass and ran into his room. Jerome stated he and other staff members used force to open the door to [REDACTED] room. Jerome stated when he and the staff members were able to get inside of the room, [REDACTED] walked out of the room and held the glass to his throat. Jerome stated he ran toward [REDACTED] in an attempt to stop him from cutting himself. Jerome stated [REDACTED] ran outside of the building toward the Seibert Building and began cutting both of his arms. Jerome stated he and other staff members were able to catch [REDACTED] and hold him down on the ground. Jerome stated [REDACTED] was assisted to his feet and walked to the secretary's office inside of the Seibert building. Jerome stated once [REDACTED] was secured inside of the secretary's office, [REDACTED] began to calm down.

MEMS #70 arrived on scene and assessed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was transported to Children's Hospital for further assessment.

Jerome was provided with the incident number and advised to contact the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office if further assistance could be provided.
