## Primary Narrative By Anthony Braxton, 03/19/20 23:06

### Suicide Threat

On 3/19/20, I (Deputy Braxton) responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road building 6 in reference to a suicide threat.

Upon arrival, I observed the Youth Group staff attempting to gain entry into one of the rooms where the juvenile was located. The staff was able to get the door open and walked the juvenile female out of the room to the lobby. I asked [REDACTED] what happened. [REDACTED] stated that she was tired of being here and wanted to die. [REDACTED] stated to me multiple times to take my gun out of my holster and just shoot her so it can be over with. I observed multiple old scars on [REDACTED] left arm. MEMS and Rescue arrived on scene. Once [REDACTED] calmed down, she was transported to Methodist Behavioral Hospital by MEMS unit 333.
