On March 26, 2020 at approximately 1908 hours, I Officer Jones, Officer Swiger and Officer Scott were dispatched to Millcreek in reference to runaway juveniles. While en route to Mill Creek, dispatch advised there was now a riot in progress at the boy's home at Mill Creek. Chief Vaughan and Officer Cutrell advised they were en route to the scene as well. Chief Vaughan then advised dispatch to contact Dallas County Sheriff Office and Arkansas State Police for assistance.

Upon mine and Officer Swigers arrival we observed numerous juveniles running and some of the subjects were fighting with the staff. I exited my unit and observed a white male swinging and fighting with the staff. I ran up to the subject who was later identified as and attempted to restrain him. tense and refuse to calm down. I advised him to put his hands behind his back and he stated no. I then placed on the ground in attempt to place him under was taken into custody and placed in Officer Cutrell's unit. Officer Rhodes arrived as well to assist in taking control of the situation. I was advised by had been assaulted and transported to several workers that a Dallas County Medical Center and also had damage to his vehicle.

Numerous staff members stated there were more juveniles that needed to be arrested because they had assaulted staff members. I observed a worker grab one of the juveniles and push him back into Tiger Hall. I heard numerous juveniles yelling and kicking the doors in attempt to escape. Officers then entered Tiger Hall in attempt to gain control of the situation. While inside another juvenile refused to comply with commands after a brief struggle with the subject he was taken into custody. Two more subjects were arrested out of the hall for cursing and causing a scene and placed in patrol units. I heard numerous juveniles stating the staff had started this and that this is there way of acting up because they were tired of being

treated this way.

We were then advised by Nurse Lora Lindsey that eagle hall needed to be controlled due to them making threats towards the staff and the police officers on scene. All units entered the hall along with assistance from the sheriff office. We were able to gain control of the hall and take several juveniles into custody for numerous charges. Sheriff Stan McGahee then left the scene to go get the Sheriff Office transport van so all juveniles could be transported at once to the police department for processing. Sheriff McGahee arrived on scene and thirteen juveniles were placed on the van and transported to the city hall parking lot. Juvenile officer Becky Cathy was contacted and advised of the situation. She advised she would be en route to assist.

While I was preparing to leave the scene, I was advised by Officer Swiger the main one that started all this was still inside and needed to be arrested. We then went inside and placed under arrest and he was transported to the police department. While en route to the police department he started all this because the staff wouldn't give him some candy. admitted to starting the riot and assaulting the staff members. Officer Scott stated he had spoken to the two staff members that had been assaulted.

All juveniles were turned over and processed by Officer Cathy in the city hall parking lot. All subjects that were arrested was released back to Mill Creek CEO. All juveniles were charged with disorderly conduct, battery 3rd degree, terroristic threatening, inciting riot and criminal mischief 1st degree.

On March 26, 2020 at approximately 1908 hours this officer, John Cutrell, was advised that they had several subjects fighting at Mill Creek of Arkansas on Industrial Drive.

This officer along with other officers from the Fordyce Police Department and the Dallas County Sheriffs Office, made entry into

the building to take control of the other juveniles that were rioting inside. The other juveniles were taken into custody without incident except one juvenile that had to be physically placed on the ground after he wouldn't listen to several commands to get on the ground.

After all juveniles were taken into custody this officer assisted in securing the scene until the juveniles were transported to the Fordyce City Hall parking lot where they were turned over and processed by Juvenile Officer Becky Cathy. This officer assisted at the police department in maintaining control of the juveniles while they were being processed. After processing, all juveniles were release back to Millcreek CEO.

On March 26, 2020 at approximately 1908 hours, I (Officer Canaan Swiger), Officer Joe Jones, and Officer Mackenzie Scott were dispatched to Mill Creek in reference to runaway juveniles. While en route to Mill Creek, dispatch also advised there now a riot in progress at the boy's home main building at Mill Creek. Chief Vaughan and Officer Cutrell advised they were en route to the scene as well.

Upon mine and Officer Jones arrival we observed numerous juveniles running and some of the subjects were fighting with the staff. I then exited the unit and observed a young white male swinging and fighting with staff. Officer Jones then advanced towards the young male subject, who was later identified as to attempt to restrain him. Officer Jones then advised to place his hands behind his back which then said no. Officer Jones then placed in cuffs and placed him in Officer Cutrell's patrol car. Investigator Rhodes responded to the location for additional assistance for the situation.

After was detained and secured I noticed a staff member running behind what appeared to be a gymnasium so I advanced towards it to see what was going on. Once I caught up with the subjects the staff informed me that they were just trying to escape so I then helped the staff get the juveniles back into there secure rooms. After all the juveniles were in the rooms many of them were still attempting to fight or escape so we advanced in Tiger Hall, which was one of the rooms the young juveniles were housed in. Once we had entered Tiger Hall we gave verbal commands for every one in the room to get on the ground. One juvenile refused to comply so he was then taken into custody along with two other male juveniles who had also refused to comply. After the juveniles from Tiger Hall were secured

another juvenile approached us and began to go for a staff member. We advised him to get on the ground so we could detain him. He complied and we were able to get him handcuffed and secured in a patrol car.

After we had Tiger Hall secure, a nurse, Ms. Lora Lindsey, advised us that Eagle Hall needed to be controlled due to the fact the young male juveniles in there were threatening the staff and also stating they were going to fight the police officers. We then regrouped and additional backup had arrived from the Dallas County Sheriffs Office along with some Arkansas State Police. We formed a plan and then took control of Eagle Hall. We took several juveniles into custody. Sheriff McGahee left to get a transport van so we could safely transport all the juveniles we had in custody which was thirteen at that time. I then went to the patrol cars that had some of the juveniles to begin to transfer them from the patrol cars to the transport van. After all the Juveniles were secure in the transport van Officer Jones then advised Officer Scott and I to go to the nurses station to talk to the victim so we could get additional information on what started the riot. Officer Scott then made contact with the two victims which were identified as Mr. Deshawn McGowan and Mr. Daquez Lawson.

After Officer Scott got there information they advised us that the one who started the riot was still in Tiger Hall. Officer Scott then advised me to make contact with Chief and Officer Jones. After I made contact with them they advised me to confirm that he did start it then arrest him. After we had confirmed with both victims Officer Scott, Officer Jones, Officer Cutrell, and I went into Tiger Hall to make contact with this male juvenile. The staff pointed him out to us and we identified him as Mr. then placed him under arrest. The admitted to starting the riot and stated he started all this due to the fact the staff refused to give him some candy.

Officer Cutrell then advised that they were en route to the facility.

Upon arrival on the scene I split off from Officer Jones and Officer Swiger to pursue a juvenile covered in blood. While trying to gain the male juvenile's attention I spotted multiple juveniles running around the property and others fighting at the main building. I pursued the male all the way down Industrial Drive to Highway 79 North. The subject then gave himself up at the stop sign of Industrial Drive. I attempted to notify dispatch of my location multiple times; however, my portable radio would not key up. Mill Creek staff took custody of the juvenile and I ran back to my vehicle.

Once at my vehicle I successfully notified dispatch of my status and proceeded to the main building on the side with the male dorm. Once I arrived at the male dorm, I regrouped with Chief Vaughan, Investigator Rhodes, Officer Cutrell, Officer Jones and Officer Swiger. Staff members informed us that a staff member named Daquez Lawson had been assaulted by many of the juveniles within the dorm. Officers entered Tiger Hall in an attempt to detain the juveniles still acting aggressive. While inside the facility all of the Juveniles were commanded to get on the ground. One juvenile refused to comply and began getting physical with Investigator Rhodes and Officer Jones so he was taken into custody. Two more juveniles then refused to comply as well and they were taken into custody. The remaining juveniles were then placed in their rooms while we took the non-compliant ones to our patrol units.

After I placed one of the juveniles into my patrol unit, the one that I had pursued earlier was brought on scene by the staff. The juvenile then began running towards one of the units in an attempt to attack one of the other arrested juveniles. I pursued the juvenile and grabbed his arm to prevent him from moving any further. A staff member identifying himself as a supervisor then approached us in an aggressive manner and began pushing the juvenile in between staff vehicles and yelling profanity at him. Both Officer Jones and myself told the staff member to stop. He was then told to leave scene; because of his belligerent behavior. The juvenile was then placed in custody and we were notified by Nurse Lora Lindsey that Eagle Hall had juveniles acting aggressively and threatening the staff. While awaiting assistance from Dallas County Sheriff's Office and Arkansas State Police multiple juveniles were witnessed slamming on windows of the facility and kicking on the doors. I then approached my patrol unit and one of the juveniles in the told me that he had a shank on him and vehicle identified as handed me a wooden stake. The stake was given to Investigator Rhodes.

We then entered Eagle Hall and took several more juveniles into custody. Once all

juveniles were detained Sheriff Stan McGahee retrieved a Sheriffs Office transport van and the juveniles in custody were loaded into the van. Once the juveniles were loaded for transport, myself and Officer Swiger made contact with two staff members, Daquez Lawson and Deshawn McGowan whom stated they were assaulted by the juveniles. Mr. McGowan stated that one of the juveniles was throwing a tantrum and instigating the other juveniles to riot because the staff members refused to give him gummy bears. I advised Officer Swiger to make contact with Chief Vaughan in regards to taking into custody. Mr. Lawson attempted to detain and it caused to become aggressive. Mr. McGowan then stated he attempted to use the gummy bears to calm down Mr. Gregory; however, he refused to settle down. Mr. Lawson then successfully escaped with the help of Mr. McGowan who stated he was hit in the face in the process; I then gathered their information. was then taken into custody and placed in Officer Jones patrol unit. All juveniles in custody were transported to the city hall parking lot. All juveniles were turned over and processed by Juvenile Officer Becky Cathy. The juveniles were then released back to Millcreek CEO.

Narrative - Rhodes, Michael - 3/30/2020 (Initial)

On March 26, 2020 at 1911 hours I was notified by dispatch that I was needed at Millcreek of Arkansas on Industrial Drive in reference to a riot in progress.

At approximately 1915 hours I arrived on scene and was advised by Officer Jones and by Chief Vaughan of the incident. I and other officers of the Fordyce Police Department and from the Dallas County Sheriff's Office entered the areas that were rioting. Upon entering the building the juveniles were ordered to get on the ground and complied with the orders given except one that was placed on the ground and handcuffed. Several juveniles were arrested and transported by the Dallas County Sheriff's Department Transport Van to the Fordyce City Hall parking lot and turned over to Juvenile Officer Becky Cathy.
