Terroristic Threatening 2nd degree

On 4/28/2020 at approximately 1410 hours Deputies had responded to the Colonel Glenn youth home to investigate a disturbance with a student.

While on scene in the area of Lockart Lane I observed Staff member Melvin Walker attempting to stop another student from walking away. I then went to the location and exited my marked patrol unit.

I observed Melvin Walker motion for a second staff member to come and assist getting the juvenile back into the building. As Melvin Walker motioned for the second staff member the Juvenile tensed up his chest in a fighting posture and stated " If you touch me I will beat your mother fucking ass". The juvenile began to step forward and I took a hold of his left hand and secured it in handcuffs. The juvenile then placed his right hand in front of him to prevent me from securing his right hand. Melvin Walker took a hold of the right arms to where I was able to place the right wrist into handcuffs.

I advised dispatch at that point that I needed a second incident number due to the threats that I had observed. The juvenile was then identified as and he was placed in the back seat of my patrol unit.

Contact was made via phone with Pulaski County Juvenile Intake Officer Roger Rasico and advised of the incident of terroristic threatening and refusal to submit to arrest. Roger Rasico advised that due to the public health factors to provide with a court date of May 19, 2020 at 0930 hours in the Pulaski County Juvenile Court.

At that point was released back to staff and walked back into the building with no other issues.

I was then advised that is an award of the state with a case worker of Tasha Meeks.
