## Primary Narrative By Elza Kirkwood, 05/21/20 22:17

### Medical

On Thursday, May 21, 2020, at approximately 1751 hours I was dispatched to 20400 Col. Glenn Rd in reference to two juveniles swallowing batteries.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Kelli Nash. Ms. Nash stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both swallowed AA batteries. When Ms. [REDACTED] was asked why she did, she stated that she needed attention and this was a way to get it. Ms. [REDACTED] stated that others were calling her a baby so she swallowed the battery.

Both were transported by MEMS, unit 84 and 75, to Children's Hospital for treatment.
