Assault 2nd Degree

On July 23, 2020, at approximately 2056 hours, I, Deputy A. Wallace, was dispatched to an assault, at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Carmen Mankey. Mankey advised that she was assaulted by one of the residents at the Youth Home where she works. Mankey advised that _____ was being disrespectful and destructive. She said that she attempted to calm _____ down and get her under control. Mankey said that _____ started eating a crayon and she attempted to stop her. Mankey said that _____ began to slap her on the arm.

Mankey said that she, along with other staff members, attempted to restrain _____. Mankey said that _____ started kicking her, slapping her, and pulling her hair. Mankey said that she didn't have any injuries and I didn't see any visible injuries. Mankey advised that she wanted to press charges because it wasn't the first time _____ had done this. The assault occurred earlier in the day at approximately 1400 hours. At the time of my report, _____ had calmed down and was sleeping.

I called the on-call juvenile intake prosecutor, Lauren Robertson. Robertson advised me to issue _____ a court date. She said I could leave the copy of the citation with Mankey to give to _____ guardian. An ADR was created and I gave a copy to Mankey as instructed.
