Battery

On (7/27/20), at approximately 0304 hours, I was dispatched to Children's Hospital, in reference to a battery. Upon my arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she was in an argument with [REDACTED] at the Colonel Glenn Youth Home. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] came into her room, and struck her in the face "at least twenty times". [REDACTED] stated that the incident happened at approximately 2130 hours (7/26/20).

I then made contact with [REDACTED] mother, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she was notified of the incident by youth home staff at approximately 2215 hours (7/26/20). I observed a mark on [REDACTED] nose, and red mark behind her left ear, and an area that [REDACTED] claimed to be missing hair on the back of her head. This markings were photographed, and will be entered as evidence.

[REDACTED] stated that she has a broken nose and that she believed she had been knocked unconscious.

PCSO was never contacted by youth home staff in regards to this incident. [REDACTED] was advised of this report, and was advised to follow up with the Prosecutor's Office to pursue charges. Due to the time of night this incident was report, I will be following up with youth staff at a later time to obtain further information.
