AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On 07-29-2020, at approximately 1908 hours, I, Deputy R. Jones, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to an assault.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] at the above listed address. [REDACTED] stated a staff member, Tara Brown, put her hands on his throat back on February 28, 2020, at the Hickory House building #2 (current location). [REDACTED] stated he was in a disturbance with another peer resident at the center and he was trying to make his way toward the other resident. [REDACTED] stated Ms. Brown was attempting to hold him back from the other resident and he pushed her away from him. [REDACTED] stated Ms. Brown would not get out of his way so he then begin throwing objects around and threw a large size lotion bottle hitting her. [REDACTED] stated Ms. Brown then put her hand on his throat pushing him back.

[REDACTED] stated he advised another staff member, Mr. Ben, of what happened. [REDACTED] stated photos were taken of his neck after the incident that occurred on 02-28-2020.

I made contact with Ms. Brown at the same address. Ms. Brown stated the current location, Hickory House building #2, was not opened in February and that she did not put her hand on [REDACTED] throat. Ms. Brown stated [REDACTED] was upset with her today due to him getting in trouble for spitting. Ms. Brown stated all of the resident's behavior got out of control today and [REDACTED] was the ringleader. Ms. Brown stated she and another staff member decided [REDACTED] needed to be separated from his peers to calm down.

[REDACTED] stated he just wanted to make a report of what happened back in February.

I provided Ms. Brown and [REDACTED] with this incident number and advised them contact the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office any future assistance.
