## Primary Narrative By Da'Vonti Armant, 10/03/20 23:43

### Assist Medical

On Saturday, October 3, 2020, at approximately 2134 hours, I (Deputy Armant) was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to an assist medical.

Upon my arrival, contact was made with medical staff at the youth center. The nurse advised that a student, identified as [REDACTED] needs to be transported to Pinnacle Pointe due to an issue that occurred earlier in the day. The nurse advised that [REDACTED] have a history of being violent with several people.

Contact was made with [REDACTED] in his bedroom. I advised [REDACTED] who I was and that he will be transported to Pinnacle Pointe by MEMS personnel. [REDACTED] understood what was told to him by the nurse and I. [REDACTED] was walked to MEMS unit 86 to be transported without any issues.
