**Narrative**

On Friday, October 30, 2020, at approximately 14:09 hours, I responded to 161 Skunk Hollow Road, to Little Creek Behavioral Health Center, for a disturbance. Upon arrival, I saw three staff members holding juvenile offender, (J1) by the arms. J1 was lying on her back on the back of the parking lot asphalt, near the garbage bins.

I approached on foot and asked what was going on. Dispatch had advised me J1 had stabbed a staff member, Taylor Decesaro, (victim) with an ink pen the previous day, but no report had been filed at that time. I was advised the staff could not get J1 back to the facility due to not having enough staff in the facility. I was told J1 assaulted, again, that afternoon, took the electronic badge from Ms. Decesaro, and used it to leave the facility building. Witness, Jeffery Kemper gave a written statement, as did Ms. Decesaro and complainant, Tyler Dixon. Those statements are included in the case file.

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I advised the staff members they would have to safely return J1 into the facility. J1 spit at and on me a few times. I turned J1 and asked the staff if they had spitting masks. They said they had none. They applied a light cloth breath mask to help. I released J1. J1 began kicking to get away. I assisted restraining J1, for her safety, until a staff member, Tyler Dixon, (others involved) could get J1's legs under control.

I contacted Juvenile Intake, Officer G. Clark, (others involved) who advised J1 could only be taken to juvenile detention if a violent felony was committed, due to circumstances of being from out of state, with all guardians being out of state. I advised him Ms. Decesaro wanted to press charges for being stabbed. Officer Clark said that should meet criteria for taking J1 into custody.

By that time, Deputy Johnson (others involved) arrived on scene. He assisted in placing handcuffs on J1. He placed J1 into the back seat of my patrol unit and helped her calm. She appeared happy to be leaving the facility. Deputy Johnson assisted J1 in getting chips and water for a snack from staff members, who provided the snack for her.

Ms. Decesaro, Mr. Dixon, and staff member Jeffery Kemper gave written statements, which are included in the case file. Deputy Johnson took photographs of the injuries to Ms. Decesaro. Those photographs are included in the patrol photos file. I looked at the injuries, including the puncture mark from the previous day. It was on Ms. Decesaro's upper left arm. It did not appear to be swollen and was a slight puncture from the tip of the ink pen, less than a millimeter in width.

While they were finishing statements, Officer Clark called back and advised me they would not accept J1 into juvenile detention. It was suggested the facility return J1 back to Pennsylvania, her home state. I drove J1 to the front of the facility and took her back inside. J1 became uncooperative at having to be back inside. She was directed to sit and wait for staff. She was still in handcuffs, placed in the front for comfort and to facilitate the snack, earlier. J1 pulled the fire alarm by the seat. She spit on Deputy Johnson, Lt. Wooley, who had arrived minutes before, and me.

Staff arrived to return J1 to safety inside the facility. I removed the handcuffs from J1. As I stepped back from removing the cuffs, J1 spit on me again.

I relayed the suggestion J1 be returned to her home state.

I called DHS to get information on what section of DHS is responsible for oversight of that facility. At time of this report, I have not received that information.
