Battery 3RD

On Monday, December 14, 2020, at approximately 1615 hours, I, Deputy K. Penister was notified of a telephone report of a battery, via dispatch.

I made contact with Mr. Barrett Harger, who is a Qualified Behavior Health Provide, for Colonel Glenn Youth Home. Mr. Hager stated on Saturday, December 12, 2020, at approximately 1305 hours, he and the some of the youth residents were in the recreation room when one of the youth residents, became upset because another peer asked to give him some space while playing the computer. began throwing books, chairs, and tables. Mr. Hager stated punched the television, and he restrained, by wrapping his arms around and interlocking their arms, walking to the seclusion room. Prior to entering the seclusion room, left arm broke a loose and he began striking Mr. Hager in the head. Once they mad it to the seclusion room, grabbed a set of headphones that were wrapped around Mr. Hager's neck, causing the headphones to collapse. At that point other employees arrived and assisted Mr. Hager in securing in the seclusion room. Mr. Hager stated he suffered injuries to his face and back, which resulted in him going to the hospital.

Mr. Harger was provided the incident report number and advised to call Pulaski County Sheriff's Office as needed.
