

**Narrative & Statements**

**Narrative - Hubanks, Chad - 9/18/2021 11:17:00 AM (Initial)**

On September 18, 2021 at approximately 1117 Hours, I was dispatched to Mill Creek of Arkansas for Three Female escapee's heading in the direction of Johnsons Warehouse. Upon arrival I searched the area behind Johnsons Warehouse and noticed two females on the ground with two female employees of Mill Creek restraining them. I rushed on scene and noticed one escapee, [REDACTED] fighting with Mary Jacobs trying to get free. I placed both escapees into handcuffs and into my patrol unit. [REDACTED] stated that Mrs. Jacobs was choking her. I advised [REDACTED] that Mrs. Jacobs was not chocking her. Mrs. Jacobs had [REDACTED] arms crossed on her chest and restraining them down on her chest to keep her from escaping again. No marks were found on [REDACTED] neck. I transported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] back to Mill Creek and released them both to their caretakers.
