Battery 2nd

On 9-18-21 about 1831 hours, I Deputy Starks was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to assault.

Upon my arrival, I met with the complainant/victim Mr. Adonis Brown. Mr. Brown stated that he was assaulted by [redacted] Mr. Brown stated that he is a youth worker for the youth home. Mr. Brown said he went over to building number 25 because the kids were become unruly. Mr. Brown stated that he went to and spoke to [redacted] about rapping and using racial slurs and the N word. At this time Mr. Brown stated that [redacted] became very upset, began yelling at him and stated, "I will bet your ass I didn't say anything like that". Mr. Brown said that [redacted] ran outside and he followed him that's when [redacted] picked up a metal pipe and hit in the head with it. I did observe a large knot on the right side of his head (see photos). Mr. Brown refused any medical attention at this for his injury. Mr. Brown stated that there were no witness outside when the assault happen.

I went and spoke with [redacted] and asked [redacted] what happen today and [redacted] story matched up with Mr. Browns. [redacted] omitted that hit Mr. Brown in the head with the pipe because [redacted] was mad and upset. I placed [redacted] in handcuff and placed [redacted] in the back of my patrol unit. I called the Pulaski County Juvenile intake and spoke with Officer M. Carter. I briefed Ms. Carter about the incident, Ms. Carter spoke to Ms. Lara Meagle, who is case manager for [redacted]. Ms. Carter stated to cite [redacted] with a court date and release [redacted] back to the care of the Youth Home. After completing the proper documents [redacted] was given a court date and released to the care of Mr. William Gavens who also is a youth home working. Mr. Gavens signed the ADR along with

[redacted] is being charged with Battery 2nd degree 5-13-202. Mr. Brown and Mr. Gavens were given

a report number of the incident. The pipe used in the incident will be placed into evidence in the PCSO property room.
