## Primary Narrative By Bradley Tucker, 10/02/21 16:42

### Runaway Juvenile

On October 2, 2021 at approximately 14:08 hours I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in regards to a runaway juvenile.

I arrived on scene and spoke with the complainant, Valerie Alvarez, who informed me that a 13 year old juvenile name [REDACTED] ran away from the Colonel Glenn Youth Home. I was informed that [REDACTED] was last seen walking to the west behind the Colonel Glenn Youth Home into the woods. Deputy Tallent and I then checked the wooded area to the west of the Colonel Glenn Youth Home in an attempt to find [REDACTED]. Deputy Tallent and I had negative results.

I then went back to the Colonel Glenn Youth Home to speak with Valerie further and to gather more information to enter [REDACTED] as a Missing/Runaway Juvenile into ACIC/NCIC. While talking with Valerie at the Colonel Glenn Youth Home, Pulaski County Dispatch advised me that [REDACTED] was spotted walking north in front of 37 Ferncrest Drive. Deputy Tallent and I then responded to that area.

Deputy Tallent and I were able to make contact with [REDACTED] on Cambridge Road at Ferncrest Drive as he was walking out of a wooded area. Deputy Tallent secured [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was resistant and tried to walk away saying "don't touch me" with his fists clenched. Deputy Tallent took hold of [REDACTED] left wrist and asked him to stop. [REDACTED] then attempted to turn and began to raise his right hand. At that time, [REDACTED] was placed in handcuffs for his safety until he was able to calm down. After [REDACTED] calmed down, he was taken out of handcuffs and he got into a Colonel Glenn Youth Home vehicle to be transported back to the Colonel Glenn Youth Home. We then followed the staff back to the Colonel Glenn Youth Home to make sure that [REDACTED] did not attempt to assault the staff. Deputies then talked to [REDACTED] and he advised that he was mad because he was grounded for not going to bed on time. [REDACTED] advised that he would calm down.

Valerie was advised that a report would be completed and was provided with the incident number.
