Battery 2nd Degree

On March 3, 2022 around 1743 hours, Deputy Bell responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (youth Home) in reference to an Aggravated Assault later upgraded to Battery 2nd Degree. Upon Deputy Bell's arrival contact was made with David Barnes who works at the youth home. Mr. Barnes stated they were having a group therapy session in which [redacted] was in attendances. Mr. Barnes stated [redacted] became disrespectful and upset while in the group session and was kicked out. Mr. Barnes stated [redacted] walked around cursing and threatening staff at the group home. Mr. Barnes stated [redacted] was swing a chain in his hand and he reached down and grabbed the chain and told [redacted] he had about 30 seconds to make a decision. Mr. Barnes stated while [redacted] was swinging a chain he hit him across the forehead and lip. Mr. Barnes stated he put [redacted] in a restrained position along with other staff member until he calm down.

Mr. Barnes sustained injuries to the forehead area and a cut on his bottom lip. [redacted] was charged with Battery 2nd Degree. While on scene at the youth home another juvenile by the name of [redacted] began to act out by threatening staff stating he would kill them. Upon the arrival of Sgt. Nutt [redacted] stated to staff and to Sgt. Nutt that he would kill them and their families. [redacted] also spit on David Barnes. Deputy Bell contact Pulaski County Juvenile Intake Officer Roger Rasico ans advised him of the incident who approved the intake of the juveniles. [redacted] was taken into custody and charged with Terroristic Threatening 1st degree. Both juveniles were taken to the Pulaski County Juvenile Detention facility.
