R911.10	Discussed repairs being made to A/C units and busted water pipe in the 100 hall. Facility is currently in the process of getting estimates and moving forward with repairs to A/C units and the water pipe. "Swamp Coolers" were placed in the affected areas of the building to provide air conditioning. Additionally, Licensing requested that the temperature be taken in all areas where children are located and document the temperature. If the temperature reaches above 85 degrees then the children should be relocated to another area with cooler temperatures.
