Incident Description: Client, a female child, was in the gym during RT and was playing kickball on 8/16/21. While client was running in gym across the room client was not paying attention to where she was running. The client was running too close to the wall and client tripped over the door stopper and lost her balance. Client fell onto the floor and injured her wrist her right hand. Client was assessed by nurse on duty on 8/16/21 and an x-ray was ordered. Client received x-ray on 8/17/21 around 10:30 a.m. Client x-ray was returned normal and no broken/fractured bones were found. Radiology Interpretation was provided by the facility and it was signed by Dr. Melanie Clark M.D. on 8/17/21 showing no acute finding and a normal x-ray.

Details from Follow-up: I, Licensing Specialist, Steven Pitts, went to the facility to conduct a building and grounds inspection and reviewed video of the incident involving female child, While reviewing the video I saw the child running along the wall chasing the ball and she fell and started holding her wrist and showing it to staff. There were two staff members shown in the video

supervising 8 kids. I saw no issues with supervision or with how staff responded to the injury. The child did not have any other children near her at the time she fell, and it looked like an accident.
