Incident Description: ■■■ got upset when a peer he is not fond of began arguing with the teacher. He began yelling at them and they began to escalate very quickly. The teacher asked them to stop arguing in turn the peer got up and then began yelling at the teacher. The teacher tried to calm him but he began to yell and the teacher and tried to hit him with his fist. ■■■ was restrained as he attempted to hit a teacher with his fist. ■■■

struggled with staff. Restraint continued as the momentum landed ■■■ and staff in the floor. ■■■ continued to struggle against staff and purposefully hit his head on the floor. Staff placed their hand under his head and he verbally expressed he was upset at this but did discontinue this behavior. He continued to talk with staff in an effort to calm down but he continuously stated that he would continue making threats and trying to shed blood from anyone in his way. Patient broke free with his right arm and hit staff in the face. Patient was re-secured and staff

continued with verbal support continued to struggle against staff and purposefully hit his head on the floor. Staff placed their hand under his head and he verbally expressed he was upset at this but did discontinue this behavior. He continued to talk with staff in an effort to calm down but he continuously stated that he would continue making threats and trying to shed blood from anyone in his way. ■■■ broke free with his right arm and hit staff in the face. ■■■ was re-secured and staff continued with verbal support. After continued restraint, ■■■ appeared to be relaxed and ■■■ agreed that he was safe enough to be

released from the restraint and could remain calm for the moment. Staff began by releasing his legs and after seeing that he was fine released his arms. ■■■ agreed that he could remain safe upon return to the house but could make no promises that he would remain safe once there. Staff encouraged him to make good decisions and utilize his coping skills as a way to deal with his frustration. He stated that he would attempt. The patient also stated that he was fine at this time and had no concerns. Nurses note: ■■■ in living area in house just walked to house from school. Pt noted to have a abrasion above and below right eye reported from "carpet burn" nurse applied

triple antibiotic ointment. Pt is agitated currently. Pt is refusing to accept PRN for anxiety at this time. Pt has respirations of 18 breaths per minute. Pt has full range of movement at all extremities and neck without pain or difficulty. Pt is alert and oriented to time person place and event.

At this point three staff restrain [REDACTED]. Staff alternate restraining [REDACTED], after [REDACTED] temporarily breaks free and punches staff member. At this point there seem to be between 6 and 8 staff present in room. At no time during video are licensing concerns observed.
