Client became upset with a peer doing recreation activity in the gym while playing basketball and hit another peer in the back of the head. Client injuried his right hand and the nurse was called to assist with the client's injury. Clients deescalate themselves and no restraint was needed. Later client was taken to Emergency Room for swelling of hand.
