Incident Description: presented to the nurses station around 4:30 pm, and complained of severe eye pain. Pt lacrimal gland protruding and clear fluid leaking out. Pt stated that pain was a 10/10. APRN was notified, and an order was place to transport patient to ACH ER for further evaluation. returned to facility accompanied by Youth Home staff at approximately 11:30pm from visit to ACH ER visit R/T left eye irritation. Client took a shower upon her return prior to receiving her pm meds per physicians order. Client stated that she was a little irritated that she spent such "a long time on her visit and nothing was done". Client is in stable condition all vitals within normal limits, BP- 120/80, Temp-98.2, P-80, R-20, Pulse Ox-97%. Orders from ER to start polyvinyl alcohol-povidon, PF, (Refresh Classic, PF) 1.4-0.6% dropperette Opthalmic drops --Administer 2 drops into affected eye two times a day as needed for eye.

Agency's Interim Corrective Action: transported to ACH ER for further evaluation. returned to facility accompanied by Youth Home staff at approximately 11:30pm from visit to ACH ER visit R/T left eye irritation. Client took a shower upon her return prior to receiving her pm meds per
