### Battery 3rd

On March 22, 2022 around 1955 hours Deputy Bell responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a battery. Upon Deputy Bell arrival contact was made with the complainant QBHP Beauty Moore. Ms. Moore stated she had gotten upset because she didn't play a certain song on her phone. Ms. Moore stated she explained to that her Pandora and YouTube apps did not work in the location they were at. Ms. Moore stated she told she would use her iTunes app to buy a song and it would play various rap songs. Ms. Moore stated she got upset because she couldn't get on YouTube. Ms. Moore stated in that moment she threw a chair at a staff member. Ms. Moore stated (another juvenile living at the youth home) went to his room and got his Simon Says game. Ms. Moore stated she thought was trying to make light of the situation to calm down.

Ms. Moore stated handed the game and sucker punched him in the face and the two of them begin to fight. Ms. Moore stated she and QBHP Jerome hunter got in between the two juvenile to break up the fight and picked up a broom and began swinging in an attempted to hit and struck Ms. Moore in the process. Deputy Bell asked Ms. Moore did she suffer any injuries or have any complaints of pain as a result of being stuck in the chest area with a broom by and she stated no. Deputy Bell made contact via phone with Juvenile intake Officer Roger Rasico who advised Deputy Bell to issue a citation for April 21.
