On March 28, 2022 at approximately 1030 hours I, John Cutrell, was dispatched to Mill Creek on Industrial Drive for a Battery Report.



Mrs. Eddington stated that on Sunday March 27, 2022 at approximately 1615 hours [REDACTED] was wanting to call his aunt Mary and didn't have the number. Mrs. Eddington said that the staff member Steven Weathers was trying to get the number when [REDACTED] began fighting with Mr. Weathers.

Mrs. Eddington stated that Mr. Weathers struck [REDACTED] in the head during the fight. Mrs. Eddington said that she called the Child Abuse Hotline but they refused to take the report because the child was 18 years old.
