Battery 2nd Degree

On March 30, 2022, at approximately 1656 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road at the Youth Home Inc. in reference to a student who was causing a disturbance and had to be physically restrained by staff. I arrived and made contact with staff members, who pointed toward a resident by the name of

was laying on the couch when I entered and when she saw me she got up and went to her room. I spoke with Scellita Drennon, who was the supervisor on duty at the time. She stated that came home from school and was upset. then started trying to tear stuff up and caused a disturbance inside of the Youth Home. Drennon stated that staff attempted to calm down and even attempted to restrain her but was unsuccessful. Drennon stated that struck one of her staff members during this incident and the staff member wished to press charges.

I then spoke with Henritta Evans, who was the staff member that struck. Evans stated that she attempted to restrain and while doing so struck her in the chest, and then demonstrated an open hand slap across the chest. Evans stated that she did not receive any injuries and that she was fine. I had Evans write out a statement, while I contacted the on call Pulaski County Juvenile Intake Officer. I spoke with Officer M. Carter, who was advised of the incident. She was also advised that was currently on probation out of Sabastian County. Carter then advised that since there was no injury that they would not seek intake and to issue her a Juvenile Citation and give her a court date of 5-3-2022 at 0930 hours.

was issued a citation for Battery 2nd Degree, based off the victim being a staff member of a DHS facility, signed the citation and it was witnesses by Drennon. was calm upon by departure.
