Battery 2nd

On 4-5-2022 at 1947 hours I, Deputy Bass, was dispatched to the Youth Home at 20400 Col. Glenn Rd in reference to a battery. Sgt. Nutt came to assist as well.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Sean Thompson, Jerome Hunter, and Beauticia Moore, staff members at the Youth Home. They stated that [redacted] had received a discipline for bad behavior and became angry. When the staff tried to calm [redacted] down, they got into an argument. They stated that [redacted] then began to physically fight them. They stated that [redacted] punched, kicked, scratched, and tried to bite staff members.

Thompson stated that he had received scratches on his left hand from [redacted] Thompson stated that [redacted] also tried to bite him on the left bicep area, but that he was able to push/pull [redacted] away from himself before [redacted] could bite down or latch on. I observed that Thompson had a scratch on his left hand, as well as redness and swelling.

Hunter stated that he had a minor scratch on his right hand, and swelling on his right palm of his hand. I observed that Hunter had redness and swelling to both the back, and palm, of his right hand.

Moore stated that she had been kicked in the right forearm, toward her elbow. Moore also stated that she remembered getting kicked in her chest, but did not observe any injury, marks, or swelling to that area when she checked herself over. I observed that Moore had a dark bruise starting to form on her right forearm, as well as an abrasion on her right elbow.

Sgt. Nutt and I arrested [redacted] for Battery 2nd, and handcuffed him (double locked). [redacted] was patted down for officer safety prior to being placed in my patrol unit. I contacted the on-call Juvenile Intake Officer, Robert Bonette, and advised him of the situation. He advised to cite [redacted] with a court date of 5-10-2022 at 9:30 AM, at Pulaski County Juvenile Court.

I then completed and ADR for three counts of Battery 2nd 5-13-202; D-Felony. was released back to the custody of the staff of Youth Home. I explained the ADR to Thompson and had him sign the ADR. I photographed all injuries on the staff members. Youth Home was also provided the incident number and information on obtaining a copy if needed.
